

- Concern for a decrease in foaling rate



Background


Average foaling rate from 2000 to 2019

- Dølahest from 50 to 62%
- Fjordhest from 50 to 65%
- Nordlandshest/Lyngshest from 58 to 76%

Average foaling rate breeds with comparable

- Shetlandsponni: 68% (at pasture)
- Islandshest: 68% (at pasture)
- Fullblod 82% (at hand)
